State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the place of use

of water heretofore appropriated under 13667

1. The source of water is an underground source in Pahrump Valley Basin, Nye County, Nevada (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 2.0 c.f.s. @ 800 acre feet (Second feet, acre feet.)

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

4. The water heretofore used for irrigation and domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M., at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 16 bears N. 45° 00' E. 70.00 feet (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.)

6. The existing point of diversion is located within NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M. at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 16 bears N. 45° 00' E. 70.00 feet (If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 13667 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 13667 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening, an air line and a parshall flume. The location of the latter to be approved by the State Engineer. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030; therefore, the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 10, 1968 Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 10, 1968 Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 10, 1969 Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 10, 1969 Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 10, 1970 Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 10, 1970 Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 10, 1970
