The applicant American Match Company City of 131 Varick Street, New York /, County of New York

State of New York, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Incorporated under the laws of the State of New York

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is (0.5) Five-Tenths of one second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-foot

3. The water to be used for cooling Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 17, T.19N.,

R. 20E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the South 1/4 corner of said Section 17 bears S. 27° 07' 51" W. 814.67 feet it should be stated.

6. Place of use Lot 5 of Block D, as shown on the official plat of the Sierra Pacific Industrial Park, as filed for record April 23, 1962, filing No. 357806, Official Records of Washoe County, Nevada. Being a portion of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 17, T.19N., R. 20E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drill a well, install pump, motor, and piping to cooling unit. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 9. Estimated cost of works \$2,000.00
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works Six weeks.
- 11. Remarks The water is to be used for cooling in a Cathobar Unit used in the manufacturing process - it will not be contaminated and will be returned to the sewer system. This is a private sewer which serves only this Industrial Park.

PERMITS NO. B9 letter APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 10, 1968
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 10, 1969
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 10, 1969
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 10, 1970
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 10, 1971
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 10, 1972
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before _____
