The applicant David A. Witts, 1000 Vaughn Building of Dallas, County of Dallas

State of Texas, hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit no. 21714

(Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is underground sources (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 5.4 c.f.s. (Second feet, acre feet.)

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

4. The water heretofore used for irrigation and domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 26, T. 9 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 26 bears S. 14° 45' E., 4250 feet distant. (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.)

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 9 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 35 bears S. 35° 35' 42" E., 2128 feet distant. (If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.)

7. Proposed place of use portions of SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, E 1/2 E 1/2 Section 26, S 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 24, NW 1/4 N 1/2 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 25, T. 9 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M. (comprising 320 acres) (Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.)

8. Existing place of use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, N 1/2 S 1/2, SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and S 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 36, T. 9 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M. (comprising 320 acres) (Describe by legal subdivisions. If presently used for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated.)

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year. (Month) (Month)

10. Use has been from January 1st to December 31st of each year. (Month) (Month)

11. Description of proposed works.

It is proposed to drill, develop, case and equip an irrigation well for sprinkling and gravity irrigation. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) (State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.)

12. Estimated cost of works \$15,000.00

13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 21714 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 21714 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening, an air line and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 13, 1968
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 13, 1968
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 13, 1968
Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 13, 1968
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 13, 1970
Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 13, 1970
Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 13, 1970
