The applicant Alfred L. and Mary M. Woodard

State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the  
point of diversion and place of use

of water heretofore appropriated under 17172

1. The source of water is underground

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 17172 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 17172 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times. The total combined amount of water granted under this permit and Permit 21506 is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If certificates of appropriation are issued under this permit and Permit 21506, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. The place of use under this permit and Permit 21506 is limited to a total acreage of 264.22 acres within the N 1/2 Sec. 34, T. 45 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.108 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 28, 1968
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 28, 1969
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 28, 1969
Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 28, 1970
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 28, 1971
Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 28, 1972
Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 28, 1972
