The applicant Pan American Petroleum Corporation 501 Airport Drive of Farmington, County of San Juan

State of New Mexico, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Incorporated in Delaware on 1-1-31 in the name of Standard Oil and Gas Co. - Name changed to Pan American Petroleum Corporation on 2-1-1957.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed spring Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.5 c.f.s. second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

6. Place of use NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36, T.3N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) It is proposed to develop seepage area into a spring by dozer work and hauling water by truck to Use Site, where it will be used for oil well exploration.
