The applicant Lawrence E. Settelmeyer of Gardnerville, County of Douglas

State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion

of water heretofore appropriated under Carson River proposed Decree # D-183 (p.11, High Flyer Ditch) (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is East Fork Carson River (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.56 c.f.s. (Second feet, acre feet.)

3. The water to be used for irrigation (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

4. The water heretofore used for irrigation (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 24, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the southwest corner of said Sec. 24 bears S. 19° 19' W., 918.8 feet, more or less. (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.)

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 25, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the west 1/4 section corner of said Sec. 25 bears S. 69° 21' W., 1918.6 feet, more or less. (If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.)

(Described in proposed Decree #D-183 as being in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec.25)

7. Proposed place of use N 1/2 SE 1/4 and NE 1/4 Sec. 23, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. (Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.)

8. Existing place of use South portion of NE 1/4 and North portion of SE 1/4 of Sec. 23, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., between Highflyer and Allerman ditches. (Describe by legal subdivisions. If presently used for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated.)

9. Use will be from March 15 to October 15 of each year. (Month) (Month)

10. Use has been from March 15 to October 15 of each year. (Month) (Month)

11. Description of proposed works.

Installation of pump and pipe to convey water from Allerman Canal

12. Estimated cost of works \$7000

14. Remarks Portion of High Flyer Ditch from existing point of diversion to south boundary of applicant's property to be abandoned. Water to be diverted from River at beginning of Allerman Canal, flow through Allerman Canal to point near south boundary of applicant's property, then pumped to High Flyer Ditch for irrigation purposes.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit changes the point of diversion of the waters of the Carson River as heretofore appropriated under the Proposed Carson River Decree, No. D-183 and is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said proposed Decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This permit is further issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in the proposed issuance of the Final Decree under the Carson River.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.56 cubic feet per second, and shall not exceed 200 acre-feet per irrigation season as designated by said proposed Decree.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1969

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 9, 1969

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 9, 1970

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 9, 1970

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 9, 1971

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 9, 1971

Commencement of work filed MAR 19, 1969

Completion of work filed MAR 19, 1969
