The applicant Was Newman of 1735 N. Wells Avenue, Reno, County of Washoe, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is effluent from Stead Sewer Plant. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.5 second-foot. One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet. acre-feet

3. The water to be used for irrigation. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 21 acres

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: within NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, T. 21N., R. 19E., M.D.B. & M., from which the W 1/2 cor. Sec. 33 bears N. 0° 11' 45" E., a distance of 276'. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use. Portions of SW 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, T. 21N., R. 19E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe Co., Nevada. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Headgate, ditches to irrigate hay crop, return water to ditch.
