The applicant Marcia Morrison of Box 1640, Pampa, County of Gray

State of Texas, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 19085

(Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is Underground (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.692 cfs (Second feet, acre feet.)

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

4. The water heretofore used for Irrigation and Domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 21, T. 26 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 21 bears S. 43° 40' E., a distance of 157.9 feet.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, T. 26 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 21 bears S. 88° 10' E., a distance of 2735 feet.

7. Proposed place of use NW 1/4 SW 1/4 (3.0 acres), NE 1/4 SW 1/4 (32.8 acres) and SE 1/4 SW 1/4 (3.0 acres), all in Section 21, T. 26 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M. Total acres 38.8 acres.

8. Existing place of use NW 1/4 SW 1/4 (3.0 acres), NE 1/4 SW 1/4 (32.8 acres), and SE 1/4 SW 1/4 (3.0 acres), all in Section 21, T. 26 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M. Total acres 38.8 acres.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

10. Use has been from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

11. Description of proposed works.

Well, pump, pipeline and open ditches

14. Remarks The well described under Question No. 5, is the same well drilled under Permit 18811. The owner of record under No. 18811 will within the next few days file an operation agreement allowing the applicant under this application to divert water and use it on the above described land in the manner as shown on the supporting map.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 19085 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 19085 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times. The total combined amount of water granted under this Permit and Permit 18811, certificate 5501, is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If a Certificate of Appropriation is issued under this permit, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said Certificate and Certificate 5501 shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.692 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 6, 1969

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 6, 1969

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 6, 1969

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 6, 1969

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 6, 1969

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 6, 1969

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before
