The applicant David and Fritzi Huntington of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.25 cfs., and not to exceed .55 mg annually, herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A meter must be installed in the discharge pipe-line near the point of diversion and accurate measurement must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the Calif.-Nev. Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed .55 mg annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 6, 1969  
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 6, 1969  
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 6, 1970  
Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 6, 1970
