The applicant Wayne C. Matley and Alouise A. Matley of Star Route, Gardnerville, County of Douglas, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 5.0 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic purposes Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T. 12 N.,

R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the southeast corner of said section 14 bears S. 8°44'E., a distance of 5,314.5 feet. it should be stated.

6. Place of use E 1/2 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, & NW 1/4 NW 1/4, S 1/2 NW 1/4, N 1/2 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 12 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Wells, pumps, pipe lines, ditches, and other structures to places of use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The total combined amount of water granted under this Permit and Permit 22447 is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If Certificates of Appropriation are issued under this permit and Permit 22447, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said Certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.1 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.
