

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Robert M. Tubb of P.O. Box 646, County of Death Valley Junction, Inyo County State of California, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Deep or Big Spring
2. The amount of water applied for is 1.20 c.f.s.
(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic
4. If use is for:
(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 17.75 Acres
(b) Stockwater
(c) Other use
(d) Power:
(1) Horsepower developed
(2) Point of return of water to stream

- 5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 18 South, Range 51 East, M.D.B.&M., from which the southwest corner of said Section 19 bears S. 39°24' W., a distance of 4613 feet.
6. Place of use 14.80 acres in the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4, Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 50 East, M.D.B. & M., and 2.95 acres in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 50 East, M.D.B.&M.

Total Acres: 17.75

- 7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Ditches
