The applicant J. H. Sewell - Liberty Livestock of Eureka, County of Eureka

State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 18651

(Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is Underground well (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 4.0 (Second feet, acre feet.)

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

4. The water heretofore used for Irrigation and domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 NE 1/4, sec. 29, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., MDM, at a point from which the NE Cor. of Sec. 29 bears N. 43°00'E. 1,920.00 ft. (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.)

6. The existing point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 29, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., MDM, at a point from which the W 1/2 Cor. bears S. 88°14' W., 1,627.7 ft. (If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.)

7. Proposed place of use N 1/2 Sec. 29, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., MDM, 280.8 acres. (Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.)

8. Existing place of use N 1/2, Sec. 29, T. 21 N., R. 53 E., MDM, 320 acres (Describe by legal subdivisions. If presently used for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated.)

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. (Month) (Month)

Drilled and cased well, and portable sprinkler system

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 18651 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18651 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times. The total combined amount of water granted under this Permit and Permit 19904, Certificate 6484, is limited to what the well covered under the two Permits is capable of producing. If a certificate of Appropriation is issued under this Permit, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in the Certificate and Certificate 6484 shall not exceed what the well covered under the two Permits is capable of producing.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 28, 1969

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 28, 1969

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 28, 1969

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 28, 1969

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 28, 1969

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 28, 1969

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before

Commencement of work filed SEP 11, 1969

Completion of work filed SEP 11, 1969
