State of Nevada, hereby make s application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Nevada Corporation, incorporated June 17, 1968

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.50 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

6. Place of use So. 1/2 NW 1/4, E. 1/2 SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 11 N., R. 43 E. M.D.B.&M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year: Month Month

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of cattle served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range. The total combined amount of water granted under this permit and Application 24754 is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If certificates of appropriation are issued under this permit and Application 24754, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0031 cubic feet per second or sufficient water to water 100 head of cattle

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 24, 1969
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 24, 1970
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 24, 1970
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 24, 1971
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 24, 1971
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 24, 1972
