DENIAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby ~~grant~~ deny the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: on the grounds that anytime that waters of the Little Humboldt River or its tributaries are to be available and used for irrigation, the State Engineer has the authority to open the irrigating season. Once the irrigating season has been opened, under the terms of Decree No. 3157, there is no surplus or unappropriated water for irrigation.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed cubic feet per second.
