

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Bighorn Investments, Inc. of Box 180, Carson City, County of Carson City, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Bighorn Investments, Inc. was incorporated in the State of Nevada on June 25, 1964.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 4.0 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

If on unsurveyed land, 7 bears N. 68° 18' W. a distance of 1485 feet. it should be stated.

6. Place of use the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, E 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 7, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 10.512 m.g. annually.
