Point of Diversion, Manner and Place of Use.

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit #24563

1. The source of water is Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.05 c.f.s. (Second feet, acre feet.)

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the East 1/4 corner of said Section 16 bears South 44° 59' East, 1930 feet.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 9, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the South 1/4 corner of said Section 9 bears South 60° 01' West, 340 feet.

7. Proposed place of use will be portions of the NE 1/4 of Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. (Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.)

8. Existing place of use are portions of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. (Describe by legal subdivisions. If presently used for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated.)

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year. (Month) (Month)

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the Point of Diversion, Manner and Place of Use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24563 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24563 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. (If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste.) The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times. The total amount of water granted under this permit and Permit 24562 combined shall not exceed 11.8 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 11.8 million gallons annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 5, 1970

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 5, 1970

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 5, 1971

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 5, 1971

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 5, 1973

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 5, 1973

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 5, 1973
