State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Incorporated in Nevada - February 9, 1967.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood the the 0.25 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second and not to exceed 17.6 m.g. annually

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1971

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 26, 1971

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 26, 1972

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 26, 1972

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 26, 1975

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 26, 1975
