

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant California-Pacific Utilities Company of 550 California St., San Francisco, County of California State of California 94104, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) incorporated in the State of California, May 7, 1928

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground
2. The amount of water applied for is 2.5 C.F.S.
3. The water to be used for Municipal and Domestic
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) (b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered) (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks") (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 29, T-36-N, R-38-E, MDB&M or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 29 bears S-58°59'54"-E, 2380 feet
6. Place of use Portions of Sections 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, 30 and 32, all in T-36-N, R-38-E, MDB&M.
7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled well, pump, motor, main distribution lines and lateral lines to users served by applicant.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works \$35,000.00
10. Estimated time required to construct works well is now drilled, additional six months
11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use seven months
12. Remarks The water from this well will be used to supplement other sources of water under control of the applicant and will be used to supply the water customers of the applicant within the City of Winnemucca and surrounding area.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined amount of water granted under this permit and permit 24652 is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If certificates of appropriation are issued under this permit and permit 24652, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 26, 1971
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 26, 1971
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 26, 1972
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 26, 1972
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 26, 1975
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 26, 1975
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before _____
