The applicant Fee Ranch, Inc. Box 67 of Fort Bidwell, County of

State of California 96112, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

Incorporated in the State of Nevada, Dec. 29, 1954

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Holy Lake and tributaries. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 1440 a.f. second-foot. One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

south end to be 1320 feet west of SE corner Sec 31 Tp 45N, R19E,

6. Place of use Bed of Holy Lake, SW 1/4, SE 1/4, NW 1/4, W 1/4, SE 1/4 Sec. 31, Tp 45 N,

Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

R. 19 E., MDM; NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 6, Tp 44N, R19E, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 1, Tp 44N,

R18E, MDM, Washoe Co., Nevada. The place of use and the area to be

inundated are identical-irrigation of natural Lake bed by inundation

of same.

Storage will begin Jan. 1, and use will end about Nov. 1

7. Use will begin about Month and end about Month, of each year.
