The applicant Lake Tahoe Recreational Land Co., Inc. 1801 Avenue of the Stars of Los Angeles, County of

State of California 90067, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Incorporated June 16, 1970, at Reno, Washoe County, Nevada. Doing business in Storey and Washoe Counties, Nevada

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 1.5 second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Quasi-municipal (Mobile Home Court) and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well with pump and motor, pipe-line connecting to storage tanks, thence through distribution system to users. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 9. Estimated cost of works..... \$75,000
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 24 months
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use..... four years
- 12. Remarks..... The water will be used for domestic and culinary purposes in the mobile home development. Approximately 3200 persons will be served with approximate future additional requirement of 4000 persons.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 114.427 M.G. annually
