

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Paul S. and Suzy Henrié of General Delivery, Moapa, County of Nevada 89025, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground source in Meadow Valley Wash. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 3.00 c.f.s. second-foot. One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic purposes. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

6. Place of use in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 all in Section 22, T14S., R66E, MDB&M, Clark County, Nevada. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.7 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 3, 1972
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 3, 1972
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 3, 1973
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 3, 1973
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 3, 1975
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 3, 1975
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 3, 1975
