The applicant Benjamin Lancaster Parker 7200 Highway 50 East of Carson City, County of Nevada 89701, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 1.0 (one) second-foot. One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Commercial and domestic purposes (Mobile Home Park and Commercial Center.) Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks") Mobile Homes and Commercial Development

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T.16N., R.20E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the South 1/4 corner of said

Section 36 bears S. 39° 05' W. a distance of 1142.70 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36, T. 16 N., R. 20 E., MDB&M Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drill 10" well, case and equip with pump and electric motor to pressure pipe distribution system. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works at least \$10,000.00
10. Estimated time required to construct works 5 years
11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use 5 years
12. Remarks Water under this application jointly with that from well described in application Serial No. _____ is proposed to divert groundwater in said Section 36 to provide water needs to serve approximately a 100 unit Mobile Home Park including a community center with laundry, swimming pool and related recreation facilities and 21.0 acres of commercial development all with lawn and landscaping entailing 36.6 acres more or less within said Section 36 herein described.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The total combined duty of this Permit & Permit 25987 shall not exceed 101.08 acre-feet per annum.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 101.08 acre-feet per annum.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 23, 1972

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 23, 1972

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 23, 1973

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 23, 1973

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 23, 1976

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 23, 1976
