of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 17862 (PBU filed 2/24/67)

from the Las Vegas artesian basin (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is Las Vegas Artesian basin (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.70 cfs (Second feet, acre feet.)

3. The water to be used for Industrial (Gravel Plant) & Domestic (no change) (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

4. The water heretofore used for no change (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point said point being in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 21, T. 21S., R. 60E., M.D.B. & M at a point from which the Southeast corner of Section 21 bears Southeast S 21° 4' E. see ltr 5-2-72 a distance of 188 feet.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within SE 1/4, SE 1/4, Sec. 21, T. 21S., R. 60E., or at a point from which the Southeast corner of Section 21 bears S. 61° 28' 24" East a distance of 1500 feet. (If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.)

7. Proposed place of use S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 and the S 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 21, T. 21S., R. 60E., M.D.B. & M. (Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.)

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as hereto fore granted under Permit 17862 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 17862 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.70 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 450 gallons of water per cubic yard of gravel washed.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 10, 1973

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before February 10, 1973

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 10, 1974

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 10, 1974

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 10, 1976

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 10, 1976
