APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

Permit 26888 is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A suitable totalizing measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water stored must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permit 26888, to store 826.67 acre-feet of water between November 1 and March 31 of each year for irrigation of 206.67 acres of the 320.0 acres of land under Permit 21186, is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and also subject to NRS 535.010. Duty of water from all sources shall not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre irrigated. The reservoir subject of Permit 26888 must comply with all applicable statutes under NRS Chapter 535. The proof of beneficial use and cultural map, when filed, must show the maximum amount of water stored and released during any one year, and the lands on which such water was used. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 27, 2009

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 27, 2012

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 27, 2012
