State of Nevada 89106, hereby makes application for permission to change the point of diversion, Plase of Use and Manner of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit #24036 Certificate #7892

Water to be developed from a 20-inch diameter cased well, 600 to 1,000 feet deep, with deep well pump and pipeline connecting to a pressurized retention tank and thence through existing pipelines to the existing distribution system.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the

following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24036, Certificate 7892 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24036, Certificate 7892, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.30 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 542,581,610 gallons annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 10, 1973
Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 10, 1973
Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 10, 1974
Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 10, 1974
Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 10, 1977
Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 10, 1977
