State of Nevada 89701, hereby make s. application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground source in Carson City (Dog pound & KPTL) Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.05 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for municipal appropriation Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: a point in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T15N, R20E, M.D.B. & M., which bears N. 63°30'40" E., 2782 feet from the west quarter corner of said Section 15. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15, T15N, R20E, M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, 6" diameter by 116 feet deep. 1 1/2 H.P. submersible Fairbanks Morse Pump. 220 gallon pressure and storage tank. All piping to fixtures, hose bibs, etc. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works. \$3,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works. Now complete in place.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use. Water is used for all service to dog pound having 30 inside cages, 18 outside runs. Serves cul-

12. Remarks. inary and waste fixtures, is used hosing out cages and slabs of building and runs, and irrigation of shrubs. In addition, this well will serve KPTL (commercial radio station) and any future developments by the City in this northeast area of the parcel.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipe line near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 10, 1973

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 10, 1973

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 10, 1973

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 10, 1973

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 10, 1974

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 10, 1974
