

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant William J. and Dolores A. Allen, dba Mill House Inn of 3251 S. Carson St., Carson City, County of Nevada 89701, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.2 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for commercial and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 29, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said section 29 bears S.36°22'08"W., a distance of 1059.94 feet it should be stated.

6. Place of use a portion of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of section 29, T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) pump, motor, storage tank and distribution system State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works \$5,000
10. Estimated time required to construct works 4 years
11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use 5 years
12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This application is at the same point of diversion and place of use as permit 20702. The same map is to be used in support of this application. Proposed new works include a restaurant and bar, 250 new units for motel, new laundry facilities (15 machines), a new swimming pool (consumption estimated at 1 gpm) 6 to 10 small shops,

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipe line near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under this Permit and Permit 20702 shall not exceed 11.32 million gallons per annum.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.2 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 11.32 million gallons per annum.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 27, 1974
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before February 27, 1974
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 27, 1974
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 27, 1974
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 27, 1977
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 27, 1977
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before _____
