

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Wallace P. Prichard Sr. of 4250 Louise Dr., Carson City, County of Nevada 89701, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Source
Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is .20 second-foot
One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet... acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Commercial and Domestic
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)...

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 2 T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. from which the S 1/4 corner of Section 2 bears S. 03° 08' 47" W. 1022.04 feet.

6. Place of use A portion of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 2 T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

Described as follows: Commencing at the S 1/4 Corner of Section 2 thence N. 0° 13' 30" E. 752.09 ft. to the true point of beginning. Thence N. 0° 13' 30" E. 353.50 ft. Thence 89° 55' 20" E. 100 ft. Thence S. 0° 13' 30" W. 300.00 ft. Thence S. 61° 52' 00" W. 113.16 ft. to the true point of beginning.

7. Use will begin about 1 January and end about 31 December, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) 6" well 115 ft. deep 3/4 H.P. Submersible pump, pressure tank and automatic controls.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works..... \$2,500.00
10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 6 weeks
11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use..... 1 year
12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Use includes commercial needs for an Upholstery Shop and Watchman's living quarters. The maximum use rate will not exceed 90 gallons per minute. Peak rate of pumping will have a maximum duration of 30 min. Average use is estimated at 600 gal/day, 5 days per week and 200 gal. on Saturday and 200 gallons on Sunday.

APPROVAL..... OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipe line near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.1..... cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.177 million gallons annually.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before..... July 10, 1974
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before..... August 10, 1974
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... July 10, 1975
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... August 10, 1975
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... July 10, 1976
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... August 10, 1976
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before.....
