The applicant..... White Pine Lumber Company, a Nevada Corporation

 State of Nevada 89501....., hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is the North Fork of South Creek and Tributaries

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:


This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.3199 cubic feet per second, or sufficient water to water 1250 head of cattle.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 6, 1974
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 6, 1974
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 6, 1975
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 6, 1975
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 6, 1976
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 6, 1976
