1. The source of water is underground - Las Vegas Artesian Basin

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.05 cfs or 4.60 AF/yr.

The water is to be diverted at the following point Located within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 31, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 31 bears S 47° 12' 59" E a distance of 404.00 feet. Said point also known as Las Vegas Valley Water District Well No. 7-A.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 25, T.20S., R.60E, M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 25 bears N 36° 56' 19" E, a distance of 796.75 feet.

7. Proposed place of use The area included within the Las Vegas Valley Water District as denoted by Chapter 167, Statutes of Nevada, 1947, as it now exists or as it may hereafter be amended. (See also accompanying plat.)

Water is to be diverted from an existing 20-inch diameter cased well approximately 930 feet deep, drilled as a replacement well for Permit No. 10867 and known as Las Vegas Valley Water District Well No. 7-A, via a deep well pump and pipeline to existing pipelines and reservoirs and thence into the existing distribution system.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the Point of Diversion, Manner and Place of Use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 15174, Certificate 4777 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 15174, Certificate 4777 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.5 million gallons annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 1, 1974

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 1, 1974

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 1, 1975

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 1, 1975

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 1, 1977

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 1, 1977
