State of Nevada 89045, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) November 20, 1973, Houston, Texas

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Ophir Creek
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.15 second-feet
3. The water to be used for Milling
4. If use is for:
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 34, T.13N., R.42E. (Unsurveyed) M.D.B.&M., or from a point from which the S.E. Cor. of Sec. 36 T.13N., R.42E. (Unsurveyed) bears S. 88 degrees
6. Place of use SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 34, T.13N., R.42E., (Unsurveyed) M.D.B.&M.
7. Use will begin about 1 Jan. and end about 31 Dec. of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Weir, fish-screen, pipe, storage tank

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 9. Estimated cost of works \$3,000.00
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works 3 mo.
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use 1 yr.
- 12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Water will be used for gravity mill for treatment of tungsten ore.
50 tons per day - water required 5 tons of water per 1 ton of ore.
After beneficiation of ore water will be settled in one or two ponds,
then discharged into a final pond, thence to Ophir Creek Flood plain.
Consumptive use not greater than 10% of diversion.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the
source. It is understood that the 0.15 c.f.s., herein granted is only
a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under
this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed
to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed
and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must
be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains
the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and
all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 21.84 million gallons annually.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 6, 1975
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 6, 1975
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 6, 1976
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 6, 1976
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 6, 1978
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 6, 1978
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before _____
