hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) October 5, 1973, Nevada

6. Place of use Lots 7, 8, 11 and 12 of Section 1, T.28N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M.

Water to be used in mining and milling operation which will rework large volumes of tailings left from early mining in the area. Total water needs are not presently known, but may be as high as 1000 gpm during periods of peak use. Estimated annual needs 750 Ac.-Ft.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water granted herein at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 28122 through 28130 shall not exceed 750.0 acre-feet per annum.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 750.0 acre-feet annually.

- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... March 23, 1977

- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... April 23, 1979
