1. The source of water is an underground source Name of stream, lake or other source.

The water is to be diverted at the following point: the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 19, Twp. 21 North, Rge. 19 East, M.D.B. & M.; from which the West 1/2 corner of said Section 19 bears S. 52° 18' W, 1894 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within. If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

Proposed place of use The NW 1/4 and the N 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 19 and portions of Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32 of Twp. 21 North, Rge. 19 East; a portion of Section 6 in Twp. 20 North, Range 19 East and a portion of Sec. 1 in Twp. 20 North, Rge. 18 East, M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use Same as in (7) above Describe by legal subdivisions. If presently used for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Day and Month Day and Month

10. Use has been from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Day and Month Day and Month

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) A system of pipes, valves and reservoirs leading to distribution of water to various industrial, commercial and residential users. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24790 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24790 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The total combined duty under this permit and Permits 27050, 27108, 28164 and 28166 shall not exceed 2400.0 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 110.69 acre-feet annually

 Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 28, 1974
