This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 14681 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 14681 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total annual duty allowed under this permit and Permits 28220 through 28226, inclusive, and Permit 28228, shall not exceed 5456.84 acre-feet.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4.42 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1243.2 acre-feet seasonally.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1975

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 2, 1975

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 2, 1975

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 2, 1975

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 2, 1978

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 2, 1978

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 2, 1978

Commencement of work filed MAY 2 1975
