The applicant Union Cab Company 1701 Western Street, of Las Vegas Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) A Nevada Corporation established in Las Vegas, Nevada on December 15, 1955. Mrs. Phyllis Frias-President, Mr. Charles Frias-Secretary Treasurer.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Las Vegas Artesian Basin Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.06 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

6. Place of use NW 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 61 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Clark County, Nevada. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about 15 July and end about 14 July following of 1974 year. Day and Month Day and Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, pump, pressure tank (500 gallon), and underground pipes. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation if and when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipe line, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2.19 million gallons annually.
