Nevada 89415 hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Squaw Spring

2. The amount of water applied for is 2 (two) second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation & domestic

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 500 acres

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec. 17 T.7N.

R.30E. The Squaw Spring diversion dam is in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of section 17 and bears N 33°20' W, 1800 feet from a metal stake set at the center of section 17 by a Registered Land Surveyor.

6. Place of use

7. Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) dam for storage, then allocated by means of pipelines and pumps to be used for irrigation

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

10. Estimated time required to construct works 1 year

11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use 3 yrs
