

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Raymond J. Wulfenstein P. O. Box 38A, of Pahrump, County of Nye Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.449 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) (b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered) (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks") (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T20S, R53E, MDBM, or a point from which the NW corner of Section 24 bears N56°12'W, a distance of 530 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use Portion of N 1/2 NW 1/4 Section 24, S 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 13, T20S, R53E, MDBM (128.5 acres +/-) and NE 1/4 Section 24, T20S, R53E, MDBM (160 acres) Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Day and Month Day and Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Construction of distribution pipe line system and appertenances State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 9. Estimated cost of works ..... \$10,000.00
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works ..... 5 years
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use ..... 5 years
- 12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

 Average consumption = 0.449 cfs.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.


The total combined amount of water granted under this permit and Permit 26373 is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If certificates of appropriation are issued under this permit and Permit 26373, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. The total combined duty under this permit and Permit 26373 shall not exceed 47.183 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.449 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 47.183 million gallons annually.

- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before ..... October 17, 1975
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before ..... September 17, 1976
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before ..... October 17, 1976
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before ..... September 17, 1978
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before ..... October 17, 1978
