APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 2.0 c.f.s., and not to exceed 8.185 million gallons annually herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined annual duty of water under Permit 28310 and Permits 36036, 36037, 36038 and 40411 shall not exceed 60.245 million gallons annually.

The beneficial use of the amount of water granted herein is subject to development approval by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency within the service area of Skyland Water Company. Should action by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency eliminate or reduce the requirement of Skyland Water Company to provide water service to the properties within the service area of Skyland Water Company, the State Engineer may (CONTINUED ON PAGE 2)

reduce the amount of water or cancel Permit 28310 consistent with this action. The State Engineer shall provide written notice to Skyland Water Company or any successor in interest of intent to reduce the amount of water granted therein or intent to cancel Permit 28310. Skyland Water Company or any successor in interest shall then have 30 days from the date of said notice to request a public hearing before the State Engineer for the purpose of presenting any additional information, evidence or testimony prior to action by the State Engineer.

The amount of water granted under Permit 28310 is based upon information submitted to the State Engineer's office by Skyland Water Company representing the estimated water need of Skyland Water Company consistent with anticipated Tahoe Regional Planning Agency approvals.

Any and all water rights obtained by Skyland Water Company for use of water from Beatty Springs shall be relinquished in favor to the State.

No water right shall be sold or transferred away from the service area of Skyland Water Company without the prior written consent and approval of the State Engineer.
