of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 26575

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the Point of Diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 26575 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 26575 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water place to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty under this permit and permits 28552, 28553, 28554, 28317 and 28318 shall not exceed 200.75 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 200.75 million gallons annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 9, 1975

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 9, 1975

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 9, 1976

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 9, 1976

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 1, 1977

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 1, 1977

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 1, 1977
