This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source.
A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 20.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 15, 1976
 Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 15, 1976
 Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 15, 1977
 Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 15, 1977
 Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 15, 1980
 Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 15, 1980
