hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Frenchman Well

2. The amount of water applied for is 1.0 second-feet

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

Water will be hauled to mill at point of use by truck and reclamation of water will be made by ponding, any loss from ponding is tributary to Oriental Wash.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water granted herein at any and all times. This permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the State Engineer's Ruling dated November 30, 1976.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 3.92 million gallons annually.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 21, 1977
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 21, 1977
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 21, 1978
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 21, 1978
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 21, 1980
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 21, 1980
