The applicant Las Vegas Valley Water District, a quasi-municipal corporation Box 4427 of Las Vegas Nevada 89106

hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 10127, Certificate No. 2674

(Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

- 1. The source of water is Underground -Las Vegas Artesian Basin
2. The amount of water to be changed 2.7 cfs or 1954.7108 AF/Yr.
3. The water to be used for Municipal Supply and Domestic
4. The water heretofore used for Municipal Supply and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point Located within the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 20 South, Range 60 East M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 27 bears N. 4° 21' 52" E. a distance of 1263.84 feet.
6. The existing point of diversion is located within the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 31, Township 20 South, Range 61 East, M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 31 bears S. 2° 38' E., 1528 feet.
7. Proposed place of use The area included within the Las Vegas Valley Water District as denoted by Chapter 167, Statutes of Nevada, 1947, as heretofore amended or as it may hereafter be amended (See also accompanying plat).
8. Existing place of use is within the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use has been from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water to be diverted from a new 20-inch diameter cased well to be drilled 600 to 1,000 feet deep. The new well is to be known as Las Vegas Valley Water District Well No. 18-A. Water will be diverted via a deep well pump and pipeline to existing pipelines and reservoirs and thence into the existing distribution system.

12. Estimated cost of works \$300,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works 18 months
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 3 years
15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This permit is being transferred from existing District Well No. 2 which due to age and deterioration must be abandoned.

 APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 10127, Certificate 2674 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 10127, Certificate 2674 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.7 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1,954.25 acre-feet annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 15, 1975
 Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 15, 1975
 Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 15, 1976
 Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 15, 1976
 Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 15, 1979
 Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 15, 1979
 Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before _____
