1. The source of water is Las Vegas Artesian Basin Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0625 c.f.s. Second feet, acre feet.

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore used for irrigation and domestic If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 28, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.M., Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be the Southeast corner of said Section 28 bears S. 80° 01' 37" E., a stated distance of 1947.5 feet.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 11, T.20S., R.60E., M.D.M., the Southeast corner of said Section 11 bears S. 53° 16' 30" E. a distance of 874.0 feet. If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use portions of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 28, T.19S., R.60E., M.D.M., County of Clark Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use in the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 11, T.20S., R.60E., M.D.M., County of Clark Describe by legal subdivisions. If presently used for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year. Day and Month Day and Month

10. Use has been from January 1st to December 31st of each year. Day and Month Day and Month

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well to be 8" casing approximately 500 feet deep with a 15 hp pump and a 3,000 gallon pressure storage tank. Water to be distributed by underground pipe lines. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 28866 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 28866 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.0625cubic feet per second..... but not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before..... December 23, 1975
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... November 23, 1975
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... December 23, 1975

- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... August 23, 1977
