

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of Lake Tahoe heretofore granted under Permit 23017 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 23017 and with the understanding that no other rights at the source shall be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit is issued as a correction of the typographical error made on the original permit terms.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.075 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.12 acre-feet annually.

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 23017 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 23017 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.075 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 1.12 acre-feet annually.
