This permit to change the manner of use and place of use of a portion of the waters of Ash Canyon Creek (aka Gregory Creek), as heretofore appropriated under Civil Decree of November 14, 1885, (King's Canyon Creek et al.) in the District Court of the Second Judicial District of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Ormsby, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit is further issued subject to the following conditions:

- The permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source with the understanding that the diversion will be regulated according to the Andersen

period of use under the present accepted rotation schedule on the stream system and further that the diversion will be subject to any changes in that rotation schedule.

2. That the works of diversion will not impede or restrict the flow of the channel in any manner.
3. That totalizing meters be installed on the diversion works with annual reports submitted to the Division of Water Resources on actual amounts of diversion.
4. That this permit is issued subject to those terms and conditions described under "Agreement For Sale of Water" between 76 Hereford Ranch, a co-partnership, and City of Carson dated November 20, 1975.
5. That the total annual amount of water diverted shall not exceed 59.0 acre-feet annually in accordance with the "Agreement For Sale of Water" described above.
