The applicant Silver King Mines, Inc. 1204 Deseret Building, of Salt Lake City, Utah 84111, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Incorporated 1961 in the State of Nevada.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Water being pumped from the Tybo Mine by way of the Hales Mine Shaft. (Underground)

2. The amount of water applied for is two second-feet (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for mining and milling operations

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) (b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered) (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks") (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Diversion at the collar of the Hales adit, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 24, T 6N, R 49 1/2 E, MDB&M, Nye County, Nevada

6. Place of use Tybo concentrator, mine, and leach plant, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 24, T 6N, R 49 1/2 E, MDB&M, Nye County, Nevada

7. Use will begin about continuous and end about, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water will be piped from point of diversion to mill site by 8-inch diameter water line, and unused portion returned to natural channel in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 24, T 6N, R 49 1/2 E (907.7 ft. S33°42' W. of NE Corner Sec. 24)
