Point of Diversion and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 11255

1. The source of water is an underground source in Las Vegas Artesian Basin Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.07 cfs Second feet, acre feet.

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Purposes If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Purposes If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 16, T.21S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the Center Quarter (C 1/4) corner of Section 16 bears South 46° 17' 57" West a distance of 1695.64 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 26, Township 21 South Range 61 East, M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the Northwest corner of said Section 26 bears North 45° 50' 00" West, 782.3 feet. If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use is within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 16, T.21S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use is within a portion of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., being ten acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26. Describe by legal subdivisions. If presently used for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year. Day and Month Day and Month

10. Use has been from January 1st to December 31st of each year. Day and Month Day and Month

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Existing well under Application and Permit No. 29051. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 12. Estimated cost of works the well is now drilled under Permit No. 29051
- 13. Estimated time required to construct works one year
- 14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use three years
- 15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This application is for 0.07 cfs not to exceed 31.42 gallons per minute and not to exceed 50.6 acre feet per year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 11255, Certificate 3232 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 11255, Certificate 3232 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.07 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 4.2048 million gallons annually.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 25, 1977
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 25, 1977
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 25, 1978
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 25, 1978
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 25, 1980
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 25, 1980
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before _____
