TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Boulder Dam Area Council, Inc., Boy Scouts of America
1135 E. University Road, of Las Vegas, Nevada 89109, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)
Incorporated December 28, 1944 in Nevada

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground waters of the Colorado River Valley of the Colorado River Basin.

2. The amount of water applied for is 22 A.F./year @ maximum rate of 0.15 second-feet. (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet.

3. The water to be used for irrigation (landscaping) and domestic use.

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 5 acres (b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered) (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks") See Item No. 12 (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: located in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 33, South, Range 66 East, MDB&M, the 1/4 Section corner on the North Line of said Section 5 bears North 27° 17' 22" West a distance of 1,120.00 feet from said point of diversion.

6. Place of use: A 15-acre parcel portions of which lie within the SE 1/4, SW 1/4 and NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 5, T.33S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) 5 HP well pump and motor connected to a pipe distribution system.

State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 9. Estimated cost of works..... \$800.00
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 3 months
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use..... 6 months
- 12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.  
 In addition to irrigation of landscaping, the well will supply a portion of the domestic water to a caretaker's residence, a latrine and shower building and drinking fountains at four Troop Site locations. Annual consumptive use of this well is estimated to be 22 A.F. per year. (This well is one of three wells proposed on the same 15 acre parcel to supply the total camp irrigation and domestic needs.)

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

No perforations shall be put in the casing until after the well is completed and the log available for study. Perforations shall not start less than 100 feet from the surface unless the log shows a satisfactory confining formation nearer the surface.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 22 acre-feet annually.

- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before..... February 15, 1977
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... January 15, 1978
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... February 15, 1978
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... January 15, 1979
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... February 15, 1979
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... February 15, 1979
