The applicant **The Cities of Reno and Sparks (c/o Sanitary Engineering Attn: Ms. Terri Svetich, P.E.)** hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **Ground Water Component Effluent from the Cities of Reno and Sparks under Permit No. 29973**
2. The amount of water applied for is **250 acft/annum-Pro-rata share of diversion rate**
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **Wildlife Purposes (Instream Flow)**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kind of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **w/in NW¼ NE¼ Section 14 T19N, R20E, MDM or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14 bears N 73 degrees 38 minutes 33 seconds E, a distance of 2,311.56 feet. Refer to map under Primary Permit No. 29973**
6. Place of Use **Refer to map filed under Permit No. 67182 to support proposed place of use The Place of use is the Truckee River at the Point of Diversion downstream to the Pyramid Lake inlet.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Treated ground water effluent will be discharged to the Truckee River and retained in the River to Pyramid Lake for wildlife (instream flow) purposes.**
9. Estimated cost of works **None-Existing works**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **None-Existing works**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **10 years**

12. Remarks: Treated ground water component effluent will be discharged into the Truckee River at the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility. This ground water effluent will be retained in the River, allowed to flow past all of the irrigation diversions and allowed to flow into Pyramid Lake.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This secondary permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions under Permit 29973 for a portion of the groundwater component of said Permit. The granting of this secondary permit is not intended in any way to waive or affect authority or requirements of appropriate water quality control agencies or regulations. This permit is further issued subject to the provisions of NRS 533.395 and the State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

This secondary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this secondary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water for secondary permits 29973-S02, 29973-S03, and 29973-S04 shall not exceed the total groundwater component of Permit 29973 being 6700 acre-feet annually and 9.26 c.f.s.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount, which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.346 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 250.0 acre-feet as decreed.**


