Colorado 80477, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed spring

2. The amount of water applied for is 120 gallons per day second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for mining Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated)

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 16, T.36N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.; or a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 16 bears N. 89° 50' W. 514 ft.

6. Place of use W 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T.36N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) install plastic pipe (40' long) to three 55 gallon drums

- 9. Estimated cost of works \$100
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works one week
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application to beneficial use one week
- 12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Water to be used for drilling in a mining operation, a minor consumptive use, but essential to the operation. Project annual use of 50,000 gallons, operating 8 hrs. per day, 6 days per week, 52 weeks per year

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.00056 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.00056 cubic feet per second but not to exceed

0.043 million gallons annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 7, 1977

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 7, 1977

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 7, 1978

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 7, 1978

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 7, 1981

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 7, 1981
